Welcome to junior rowing at Worcester Rowing Club.

Enclosed you will find the documents you need to enable your child to start rowing!

**Please do not send in the forms and money unless you have been asked. As of this moment we are up to capacity so we cannot offer complete beginners a place immediately. However, we can put you on our waiting list and recommend that you keep in contact with us by emailing the Juniors Coordinator at [JuniorCoordinator@wrc1874.co.uk](mailto:JuniorCoordinator@wrc1874.co.uk) periodically**

### Documents:

- 1) The junior's application form – This gives us pertinent information on health and swimming ability, along with parental consent in the unlikely event of injury. It also affords us the opportunity to take photographs/videos for training purposes or for junior news bulletins. Photos may occasionally appear in the local newspaper under the sports section or on the club's website. If you do not wish photos to be taken of your child you must write to the Captain, Worcester Rowing Club, Grandstand Road, Pitchcroft, Worcester WR1 3BJ

- 3) Standing Order form. If you elect to pay monthly, a completed and signed copy must accompany your membership form.

### Payment of Subs:

**Registration fee: £15** – Cash or cheque made out to Peter Powell. This is non-refundable

**Subs: £96 (first year)** – Cheque made out to Worcester Rowing Club

**Standing Order:** If you wish, you can elect to pay £8.00 per month (first year) by Standing Order. We will require the first three months in advance by cheque made out to Worcester Rowing Club (or cash) for £24. This is addition to your registration fee.

**No junior will be allowed onto the water or other training equipment until the application forms are completed and first three months subs paid**
